## Four "On The Shore"

A-Ga-Ming Resort, Boasting Four Courses near Traverse City, Michigan, is Built for Your Next Group Getaway

It has been said that a picture is worth 1,000 words. The sprawling photo above by *Midwest Golfing Magazine's* Director of Photography Paul Seifert might just be worth our entire issue.


Taken on the afternoon of May 13th, 20 minutes after a brief rain shower, the beauty of Torch Lake is idyllically complemented by a stunning rainbow and the breathtaking par-3, 208-yard 7th hole, which overlooks the 19-mile-long, 310-foot-deep lake. Northern Michigan's Torch Lake doesn't need much accentuation, as in 2016 *National Geographic* named it the thrird most beautiful lake in the WORLD.

2025 is a huge year for A-Ga-Ming and their staff, as two of the four courses are celebrating important anniversaries. "It is amazing how time does fly," began Brown. "Sundance opened in 2005, so we are thrilled to be celebrating the course's 20th anniversary this year. Sundance was the third best new course in the country when it opened and has just gotten better over time. In

were honored to receive the Best Course in the State award from the Michigan Golf Course Owner's Association and finished in the top four in the country. The Torch Course is also celebrating its 50th anniversary in 2025, so we have a lot to talk about," ended Brown.

The aptly named **Torch Course** is one of four properties at three locations under the **A-Ga-Ming Resort** umbrella co-owned by General Manager Mike Brown and Director of Golf Larry Lavely. "A-Ga-Ming" is native American for "On The Shore," but the overall vibe at A-Ga-Ming is decidedly Northwoods-laid-back splendor.

What local and traveling golfers love to talk about are premium course conditions, the ability to test their games on four distinctive layouts, and A-Ga-Ming's affordable





in our local wineries, brew pubs, and distilleries as a post-round activity. We are not very far from the thriving Elk Rapids and Charlevoix restaurant scene plus groups often spend time relaxing on Torch Lake with a pontoon rental to round out their trip," concluded Brown.

Variety is the spice of life and at A-Ga-Ming that adage is at the heart of their success. Sundance Course features wide fairways, sculpted greens, and breathtaking vistas set on a glacier-carved bluff between

Torch Lake and Grand Traverse Bay. MGM agrees with the Michigan Golf Course Owner's Association as the course builds to a natural crescendo that is high on shot values and vistas. The Jerry Matthews 6,886-yard, par-72 layout is no pushover either, as holes 14 through 18 present a diabolical stretch that concludes with a stunning, mid-range par-3 and the water-laden, dogleg right, 459yard, par-4 18th. Expansive bunkering and heather-clad mounding on nearly every hole only add to the experience and transport players to an across-the-pond feel in the process.

Torch Course is a shot-maker's gem that emphasizes accuracy, with water hazards on 11 holes. Measuring 6,369 yards and playing to a par of 71 from the tips, the Chick Harbert/Jerry Matthews design weaves through Northwoods forests with gently undulating fairways and greens. According to Brown, female golfers really gravitate to this layout, calling it one of their favorites in the area. A-Ga-Ming might mean "On The Shore," but from my perspective it could also stand for "daunting par-3s" as their quad squad measure in at 218, 208, 187, and 180 yards respectively from the tips. Both the properties share

enjoy delicious meals and beverages without leaving the premises. MGM highly recommends the club wrap, which can be split in two it's so large!


